
I received some time ago your letter enquiring about the history of Cambusvie Hospital and I am sorry that I have been unable to give any reply until now. Unfortunately my own connection with Cambusvie Hospital is comparatively recent - since the Reorganisation of the Health Services in April 1974. The same Reorganisation has made it difficult to lay hands on the early records of the hospital.

The following information, however, may be of preliminary use to you:-

- (a) The Hospitals and Health Service Year Book lists Cambusvie Hospital as having 35 beds for Chronic Sick.
- (b) The Hospital was built in two stages, the main interconnected blocks in 1905 (I believe by Messrs Spiers of Glasgow) and the two detached blocks in 1932.

I am continuing to make enquiries, as and when possible and I will write to you again if I turn up any information which I think might be of value to you.
