- A BOOKING FEE** is charged by the Links Authorities for each Start Time reserved. This fee is generally £2.00 per start time, but a special reduction has been granted to the St Andrews Branch of 50%. The Branch hopes to be able to defray this charge from their own resources, but it may be necessary to charge teams whole or part of their booking fees.
- ENTRY** should be made by letter addressed to Secretary Royal British Legion Scotland, 83 Market Street, St Andrews, Fife, — to arrive not later than SATURDAY, 19th, April 1975.
- Entries **MUST SHOW** — Name of all players
of Branch
Certified Lowest Current Handicap for each player
(Club to be shown)
and the appropriate entry fees included for each player for each competition being entered.

Branch Team Entries for the Silver Poppy must be signed by a Branch office bearer, and his office shown.

Cheques/Money or Postal Orders should be made payable to "Royal British Legion, St Andrews".

All entries will be acknowledged when start times are sent out after 19th, April. If a telephone number is included with entries and a request made for acknowledgement of entry before that date, every effort will be made by the Organising Committee to comply.

Entries by telephone to the St.Andrews Branch CANNOT be accepted.

Entries may be restricted by the Committee, but only if the block start times reserved cannot be increased. In such case, preference will be given to entries by date of receipt.

Late Entries may be Start Times remain available, if a telephone contact is provided for confirmation.

THE COMMITTEE reserve the right to accept or reject any entry; to allot or alter handicaps on the day if deemed necessary, and to fix or alter starting times. The decision of the Committee on all matters shall be final.
