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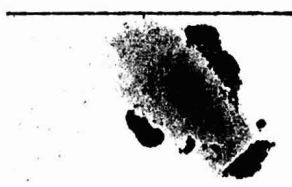

I, ALEXANDRA ROSE NISBET, Spinster, residing at Braemore, Dornoch, SUTHERLANDSHIRE, In Consideration of the sum of EIGHT HUNDRED AND TEN POUNDS now paid to me by Walter Edward Johnstone, M.B., Ch.B., Medical Practitioner, Brora, and Daniel Johnstone, M.B., Ch.B., Cromarty, the Trustees nominated by and acting under the Last Will and Testament of the now deceased Robert Ross Johnstone, Chemist, Dornoch, dated the Second and registered in the Books of Council and Session the Eleventh both days of November, Nineteen hundred and thirty, out of the trust funds under their charge as Trustees foresaid, of which sum I acknowledge the receipt and discharge the said Walter Edward Johnstone and Daniel Johnstone as Trustees foresaid, Do hereby assign to the said Walter Edward Johnstone and Daniel Johnstone as Trustees foresaid, a Lease dated the twenty second day of November, and twenty eighth day of December, both in the year Eighteen hundred and sixty seven, and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines applicable to the County of Sutherland the Eighteenth day of April Eighteen hundred and seventy, granted by His Grace the Duke and Earl of Sutherland in favour of Mrs Alexandrina Rose Munro or Mackay, Postmistress, Dornoch, of the subjects therein described situated in the Royal Burgh of Dornoch and County of Sutherland, my title to which is recorded in the said Division of the General Register of Sasines of date the twenty fifth day of April, Nineteen hundred and twenty seven, but in so far only as regards the subjects particularly described in the said Lease with the exception of the portion thereof assigned and particularly described in an Assignation granted by the said Mrs Alexandrina Rose Munro or Mackay in favour of Alexander Leslie, Writer Dornoch, dated the first and recorded in the said Division of the General Register of Sasines the twenty first both days of June, Eighteen hundred and seventy one; with entry as at the term of Whitsunday Nineteen hundred and thirty one; And I assign the rents as from the said term of entry; And I grant warrandice; And I bind myself to free and relieve the said Walter Edward Johnstone and Daniel Johnstone/
