There will also be cash prizes for the best fancy dress taking part in the junior and adult pram races! We would love to see you taking part!

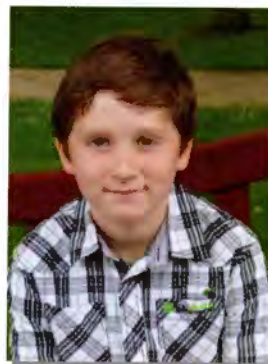

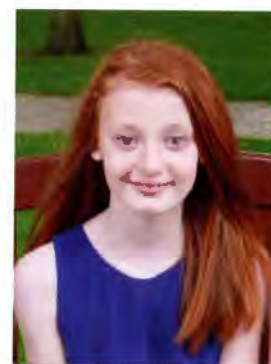

125g white chocolate

Method :

Line baking tray with greaseproof paper, melt chocolate, chop apricots raisins and almonds finely. Stir into melted chocolate, add coconut, roll mix into small balls, place on baking tray, leave to set, transfer into paper cases.


