HEATHERWOOD PARK is a development of Norwegian bungalows constructed to a very high standard, well insulated including double glazing, making for comfortable holidays at any time of the year. Lettings are normally on a weekly basis but during the winter in particular, shorter periods and special holiday breaks are available.

The bungalows are well spaced from each other and to preserve the special character of the park, there are no commercial developments such as shops, kiosks etc. Every endeavour is made to provide quiet peaceful surroundings for our visitors.

An exceptionally high standard of comfort is to be found with fully carpeted bedrooms and living area, all tastefully furnished and well equipped.

There are two double bedrooms, one with double bed the other with twin beds and each bedroom includes a combination twin wardrobe and dressing table unit with cupboards above. Continental quilts, underblankets and pillows are provided. There is also a wall convector heater in each bedroom.

The living area is of a good size, well furnished including a bed-settee suite, television and a radiant glow fire.

The living area is separated from the kitchen by a large table divider unit and six dining chairs. The living area is a full range of fitted units in the kitchen area, a standard four burner cooker, refrigerator, spianarise and all the utensils, crockery, cutlery and glassware likely to be required.

The fully fitted bathroom includes such items as a bathroom cabinet, shaver point and tidy dry line above the bath.

Electricity is by meter, and visitors are required to bring their own sheets, pillowcases, towels, etc.

Arrangements can be made for the provision of a cot and matress if required.
