a) 5 embroidered double sided blue pouches all empty with the motto of the National Rifle Association of SIT PERPETUUM 1300-1500 1860 and 2 standing figures one with bow and arrow, one with a rifle.

b) 2 coins on presentation board – 1 silver with 'Confederation Ontario 1867-1957' around a shield and 1 copper alloy with 'minted by the Ontario Government to Commemorate the role of mining in the development of Canada. Containing gold, nickel, zinc, platinum, silver, copper, iron' around a figure with several buildings behind him.

f) Silver pin with ‘Wimbledon 1882 won by Sergt. R Mackay’ set in a presentation plaque
