IN MEMORY OF
HUGH McCULLOCH
SHERIFF OF THIS COUNTY
BORN IN DORNOCH DECEMBER 17th
DROWNED ALONG WITH 98 OTHERS
ON THE MEIKLE FERRY 16 AUGUST, 1809
HE WAS A MAN UNSURPASSED IN HIS DAY
FOR LOFTINESS OF CHRISTIAN CHARACTER
MIGHTY IN THE SCRIPTURES
FERVENT IN PRAYER AND PRE-EMINENT IN PIETY
OCCUPIED AN OUTSTANDING PLACE
ALIKE IN THE LOVE OF THE CHURCH
AND IN THE GENERAL ESTEEM
ABOUT 80 YDS TO THE NORTH WEST OF THIS SPOT
STOOD THE MEETING HOUSE
IN WHICH FOR MANY YEARS ON SABBATH EVENINGS
AND ESPECIALLY AT NOON AND SATURDAY
WHEN WORSHIPPERS WERE ATTRACTED
NOT ONLY FROM THIS
BUT ALSO FROM SURROUNDING PARISHES
HE HELD RELIGIOUS SERVICES WHICH PROVED TO MANY
A SOURCE OF DEEP SPIRITUAL REFRESHING.
