Dear Madam,

With reference to your letter of 28th November 1918, I very much regret to say that exhaustive enquiries have failed to trace the grave of Captain R.H.W. Rose, and it is feared that there is now little chance of ever finding it.

I am informed that a cross has been erected at La Boutillerie in the vicinity of Fleurbaix, which is South-West of Armentieres, to the memory of Officers, N.C.O's. and men of the Scottish Rifles who fell in action during October and November 1914, and your husband's name appears on it.
